COMMUNICATION PURSUANT TO RULE 408

Dear Bill:

The Corsicana Independent School District (Corsicana ISD or the District) is in receipt of your correspondence dated March 6, 2024, regarding alleged violations of the Voting Rights Act. While the District is open to exploring ways to address the concerns you have raised through further dialogue and mediation, it would like to do so after the current election cycle.

To that end, the Board of Trustees currently has three seats up for election on May 4, 2024—Place 3, Place 4, and Place 6. The current Trustees believe having the new Trustees be part of any discussions regarding wholesale changes to the Board's election system is beneficial to the process. In addition, Superintendent Diane Frost recently announced her retirement and, as such, Corsicana ISD is in the process of hiring a new Superintendent who will, hopefully, be in place by early June 2024.

With these considerations in mind, the District would like to schedule a mediation for June or July 2024, to see if resolution can be reached short of engaging in litigation. Ahead of the mediation, I would appreciate any data you could share regarding the potential change to the election system. I am happy to enter into a confidentiality agreement to help facilitate the exchange of information.
